Froglife is seeking to recruit a Learning Officer with a conservation & education background to manage the Glasgow Green Pathways scheme and a range of other short term projects across Scotland and the North of England. This post will require travel and overnight stays.

Learning Officer

Full-time 5x days per week (flexibility is essential and sessions will include after school hours and Saturdays)

Contract: 1 year (with the possibility of extension subject to funding)

Salary: £22,500

Based in Glasgow the Conservation Youth Worker will be expected to take a leading role in delivering and developing the Trust's work with young people referred to Froglife by a range of partners who are working with vulnerable and hard to reach young people. The role includes promoting conservation activities and the provision of a training scheme utilising the Trust's existing educational, training & habitat resources. The postholder will develop a new model of delivery to include after school & Saturday sessions.

The successful candidate will have at least two years previous work experience, preferably in a similar line of work and will be willing to travel and stay overnight as required.

The post will be line managed by Froglife's Head of Learning and Communications.
