

SOCK TADPOLE



To make a tadpole you will need:
A light coloured sock
Fabric Glue or needle and thread
Stuffing for the head
Marker Pens
Google eyes or you can draw on eyes
Light material for the side parts of the body



Step One:

Stuff the toe of the sock with stuffing and then carefully cut the rest of the sock to create the tail. You can do this by marking the side to create a triangular shape then cut this out.



Step Two:

Carefully glue or stitch one side of the tail to the end then continue onto the other side, leaving a hole to fill the tail.

Step Three:

Stitch up the hole left once tadpole has been stuffed. Now using your lighter material cut into stripes to sew around the body to make the side parts of the body. These can be trimmed down to give it wiggly tadpole look!



Step Four:

Glue on the eyes and using a marker draw on the tadpole spots.
