

NATURAL ART

Instructions for teachers



1. Give out some pictures of toads and frogs.
2. Discuss the main differences between toads and frogs.

COMMON FROGS	COMMON TOADS
Stripy back legs	Golden eye
Moves by jumping	Moves by crawling
Eye stripe	No eye stripe
Lays eggs in clumps	Lays eggs in strings
Skin is wetter	Skin is drier and bumpy
Circle behind the eye	Rugby ball shaped lump behind the eye
Prefer smaller ponds	Prefer larger ponds or lakes

3. Split into frogs or toads teams.
4. Look at some pictures of Andy Goldsworthy's art.
5. Ask each group to make a picture of their animal using natural materials such as sticks, cones and leaves. Make sure they include key identifying features.
6. Ask each group to explain their picture to the other team.
7. Take a picture of your art and share it with Froglife. Leave the pictures for others to enjoy too!
