Office:	Working from home and London office

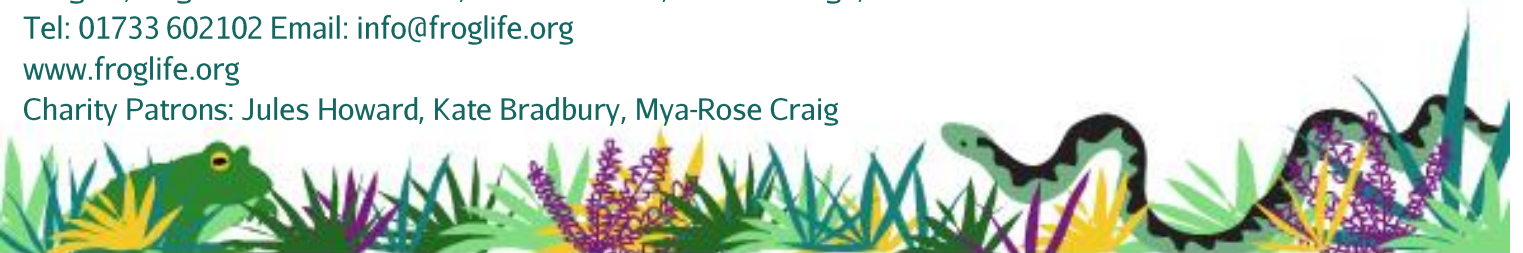
This post-holder is responsible for developing a project to create a London Blue Chain along the route of the Green Chain Walking Route in South London and completing the required documents for the National Lottery Heritage Fund application. The Blue Chain will both connect a corridor of freshwater habitats and connect local disadvantaged communities with their local heritage. If the grant application is successful and work performance is good, there will be the opportunity to apply for the Project Manager (delivery) role which will be a 3 year post beginning once the development application has been assessed. The post will report to the Operations Manager and will liaise very closely with the Senior Management Team.

Job description

The main areas that have been prioritised for the development phase are as follows:

1. **Develop a detailed activity plan identifying specific activities, venues, timings, audiences, volunteers and other support requirements. This project is specifically aimed at ethnic minority communities that are currently not engaged in nature conservation. Main activities to develop:**

- ✚ Blue Chain Habitat creations: 10 large pond creations using suitably qualified contractors and 90 small to medium community created ponds.
- ✚ Blue Chain Guardians: Recruit and train 165 guardians to maintain the Blue Chain and to relay important conservation messages to users of the Green Chain.
- ✚ Blue Chain Neighbourhood Wildlife Corridors: Create 5 corridors one in each borough (Bexley, Lambeth, Lewisham, Greenwich and Bromley) with a total of 50 interventions.
- ✚ Blue Chain Learning: Delivering nature focused educational sessions to 2,600 children and young people. Utilising Froglife's Educational Curriculum and the wide range of engaging educational activities that exists.
- ✚ Blue Chain Links: Doing Podcasts with 540 Green Chain users.
- ✚ Blue Chain Festivals: One large scale festival at each of the 10 large pond sites.

2. **Develop an Audience Development and Communications Plan.**

To include:

- Identifying how to attract the target audiences.
 - Identifying project promotional materials and scheduling into activity plan.
 - Identifying translation requirements and which materials need to be translated. Obtaining quotes from suitably qualified translators.
3. **Obtain Letters of Support from community groups/leaders/connectors, schools, colleges, NGOs and individuals.**
 4. **Work with the Conservation, Evaluation and Research Manager to set up a robust evaluation protocol.**
